

**TRAINING OF VEGETABLE FARMERS ON GOOD AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES
BY THE PLANT QUARANTINE DIVISION OF PPRSD**

Following the persistent and continued interceptions of horticultural produce from Ghana to European Union due to the presence of harmful organisms (thrips, white flies, false codling moth larva, fruit flies etc), the West Africa Agricultural Productivity Program (WAAPP) provided funds to build the capacity of vegetable farmers found in the affected areas. The objective of the training was to build the capacity of vegetable growers in Good Agricultural Practices in order to supply safe and high quality vegetables to both the local and international markets. Through the support of WAAPP, farmers in the Ga Central, Keta Municipality, Nsawam Gomoa East, vegetable farmers acquired knowledge and skills on Good Agricultural Practices (GAP's) and Market Quality Standards.
